We're super excited to jump into term 4 After School Fun.

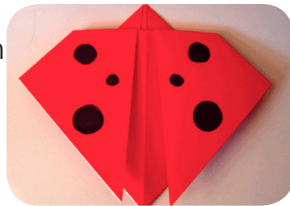

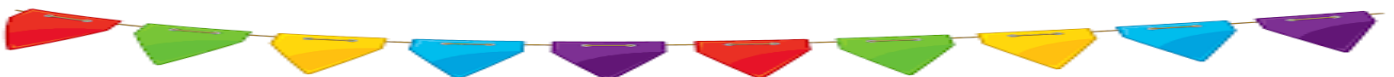

▶ HEALTH ADVICE

Chicken Pox

We have had further confirmed cases of chickenpox throughout the holidays and lots of kids off since the start of Term. Please find outlined below information for your further reference.

Chickenpox is a viral illness caused by the herpes zoster virus. In children it usually causes a relatively mild illness. Chickenpox in adults, immunosuppressed people and during pregnancy can be severe.

Parents/caregivers should seek medical advice if your child suffers from signs and symptoms of this disease.

Symptoms: Slight fever, runny nose and a rash that begins as raised pink spots that blister then scab.

Cause: Viral illness caused by the herpes zoster virus.

Spread: By droplets from the infected person coughing or sneezing and/or contact with secretions on unwashed hands. Direct contact with fluid from the blisters. People are infectious from 1-2 days before the rash appears and up to five days after.

Incubation: 2-3 weeks from exposure to illness.

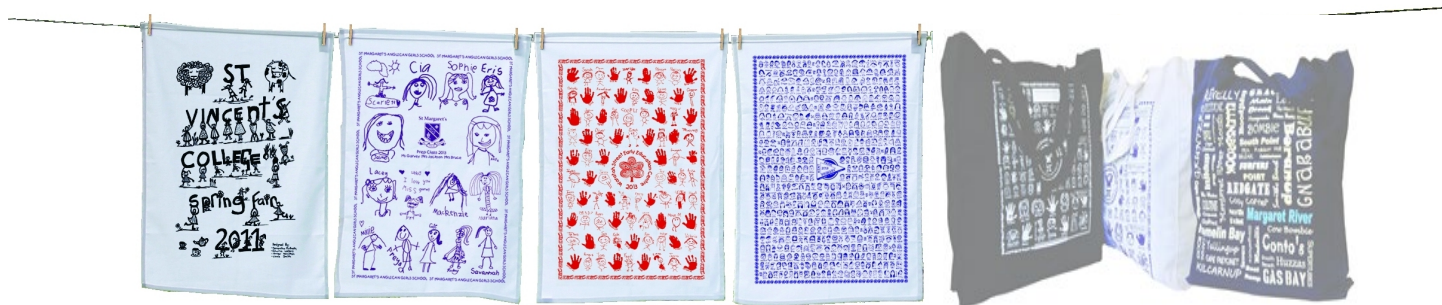
