Activities change each week and healthy snacks are provided.**

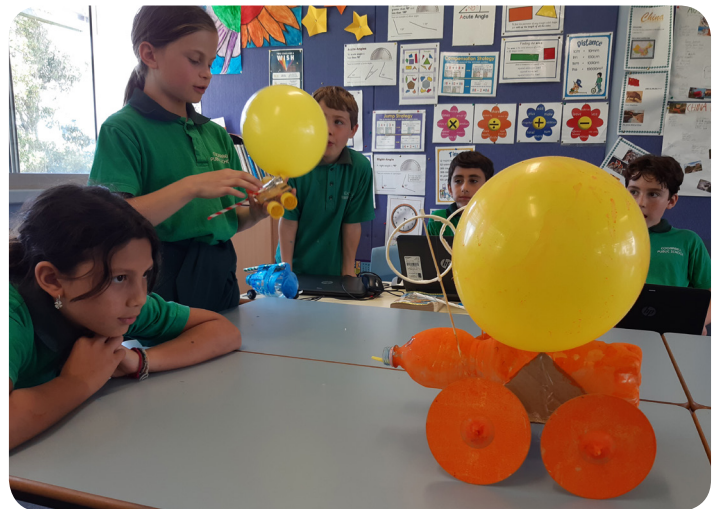
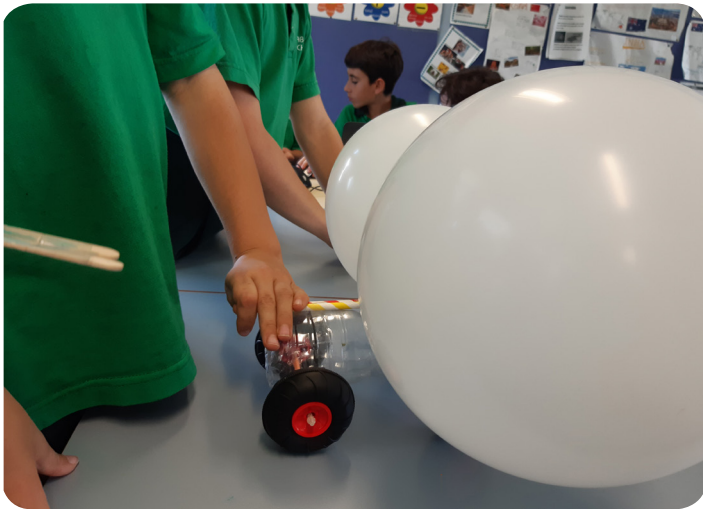
