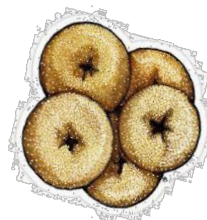
Crunchy taco shells

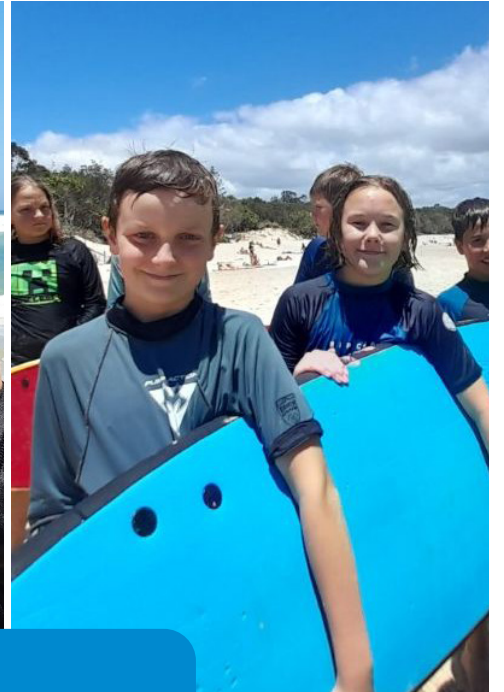
