

BANGALOW TENNIS CLUB



Ollie and Miles are 10 year old twins who have lived in Bangalow for most of their lives. Having found a passion for tennis

they are dedicated and they train hard to continually improve themselves. They are often seen on the Bangalow courts hitting balls early before school.

In 2022 they both played in the Under 10's regional league and qualified for final playoffs in Grafton. Ollie progressed through to make the State Finals in Sydney where he finished an impressive 13th.

After three tough regional qualifying rounds this year, they have both been selected to join an elite team of 5 boys and 5 girls to represent the North Coast Primary Schools region (covering Taree to Tweed Heads), in the NSW State Primary School Tennis Finals to be held over 4 days at the prestigious grass courts of the Albury Tennis Association from 08-11 May.


